

Machine Applique

Stamp Class by Debra Gabel

Supplies:

- STAMP Pattern by **zebra patterns**
 - Fabric and supplies as noted on pattern
 - A good sharp pair of cutting scissors
 - Rotary cutter
 - Pins
 - An applique pressing sheet
 - An iron
- Matching threads for every part of the flower design
- Sewing machine with open toe zig zag foot, machine darning or embroidery foot, pins



NOTE:

Leave these in your car until you finish fusing together. Most students do not get to sew during class - but if you are speedy - you might.

Homework:

1. Cut batting to size
2. Depending on what stamp you have chosen - **cut and sew** together background of stamp. Most of stamps have a sky, land and water. Some have only two pieces - others have four or five pieces. These are the straight pieces that have no fusible. Cut those pieces and sew together to make full background of image.
3. Cut and sew black and white stripe to top and bottom of background.
4. Cut your dark blue borders.
5. Have your white for scallop stamp edge fabric cut with stabilizer applied. (You can cut scallops in class or before hand.
